Our 2017 Pinot Noir was hand picked from our 175 acre organically farmed home ranch, located on the bench lands at the headwaters of the Russian River in Redwood Valley, CA.

After being delivered to our winery 5 miles down the road, the grapes were crushed and moved to stainless steel tanks where they underwent primary and secondary fermentation. The resulting wine was then racked to barrel where it was aged for 11 months.

This lovely Pinot Noir opens with an intriguingly spicy aroma. Lush black cherry notes on the palate follow through, and aging in French oak barrels has contributed a long finish with notes of vanilla and coconut. The tannins are soft, but the rich, full body of this wine enable it to complement even a hearty dish.
