Winemaker Notes:

On a bucolic eastern hillside overlooking Lake Mendocino sits Bella Collina, a 20 acre vineyard dedicated to zinfandel and petite sirah vines that have been organically farmed by the Barra family for over 20 years . The unique micro-climate of this hilltop vineyard provides an ideal growing environment, producing lush, full-bodied fruit that beautifully captures the essence of Mendocino County.

Aromas of ripe plum, black cherry and spice welcome you in, while flavors of ripe strawberries, licorice and cocoa blend together to captivate your palate. The petite sirah lends lush, round tannins, and a beautiful squid ink hue. A splash of cabernet rounds out the offering with dark fruit flavors.

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
