



2021 CHARDONNAY

This wine opens with an aromatic nose of ripe pear, vanilla, banana and warm caramel notes. On the palate, its richness is balanced by refreshing acidity and delicate accents of peach, fresh sourdough, and honeysuckle. Captivating flavors of caramel, shortbread and stone fruit round out the palate and leave a long, lingering finish.



2021 PINOT NOIR

Light to medium ruby in color with bright, zesty aromas of fresh crushed cherries, red licorice and oak spice. On the palate, flavors of red currant, vanilla and coconut. The ageing in small French coopered barrels harmonizes the fruit with a touch of sweet oak character, delivering a mediumbodied, yet delicate wine that is perfectly balanced.



2019 ZINFANDEL

This zinfandel has all the bright, brambly boysenberry fruit that this variety is known for. Fruitforward flavors abound, accompanied by cedar, nutmeg, anise and graphite. This wine is medium-bodied with round tannins. 11 percent petite sirah in the blend adds enough extra structure to make this an ideal accompaniment to flavorful foods like roasted duck, ripe cheeses or grilled lamb. 2020 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This wine displays a beautiful deep ruby hue with alluring aromas of dark cherries, blackberries and sage. On the palate, the layered flavors of black currant, cocoa and espresso give way to notes of roasted nuts and baked blackberry pie. Supple, rounded tannins provide for a balanced mouthfeel and an elegant, velvety finish.



2019 PETITE SIRAH

This wine offers up generous and dense aromas of blackberry and red licorice that linger with intensity. A slight almond husk aroma adds dimension and complexity to the deep, dark fruit. On the palate it is full bodied with an explosion of soft mouth watering fruit that is also dense with chewy flavors of chocolate and berry. (moving to new label with 2020 vintage)
